Executive's Report

STUDY SESSION

- a. **Roots of Computer's Flexible Power:**
 1. Binary Language as the Basic Architecture
 2. We can easily transfer the binary codes to Magnetic Device (Hard disk; Floppy disk; and ZIP disk) and Electric Device (Random Access Memory -- RAM), so that we can modify them like a piece of cake.

Binary (They; 8 bits = 1 byte) <i>Easy to Copy</i>	Hexa-decimal (Encoding) <i>Compact</i>	Character (We) <i>We can read</i>
01000001	41 (0x41)	A
01000010	42 (0x42)	B

01100001	61 (0x61)	a
01100010	62 (0x62)	b

Hexa-decimal uses following 16 digits-characters for encoding,

0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, A, B, C, D, E, F (total 16)
